




# Types of Rock

Rock Group	Formation
<p data-bbox="449 483 617 526"><b>Igneous</b></p> 	<p data-bbox="835 488 1514 570">These rocks form when molten rock (lava or magma) cools and crystallizes.</p>
<p data-bbox="401 690 667 732"><b>Sedimentary</b></p> 	<p data-bbox="835 695 1759 870">Particles of other rocks and minerals or once-living things are moved by water, wind, ice, or gravity and eventually settle in layers. The layers are compacted and cemented to form a new rock.</p>
<p data-bbox="388 1031 667 1073"><b>Metamorphic</b></p> 	<p data-bbox="835 1036 1520 1117">These rocks form from other rocks that are changed by heat and pressure.</p>
